

## JCHP Stall Clean Out Jefferson County Fair Grounds

Under the "Participation" statement in the JCHP handbook: "Members are also expected to assist with the stall set up night (April 2008) and with weekly stall cleaning nights which will be assigned by the 4-H club for Monday nights throughout the summer".

What is stall clean out?

The fairgrounds rent out the facilities to numerous organizations for holding open and breed shows throughout the summer. At the conclusion of the shows, the stalls must be cleaned. That's where the JCHP organization comes in. Each club is assigned 3 clean out nights. Project members earn points for each stall that they clean. Each point has a \$1.00 value.

Why does the JCHP participate in Stall Clean Out?

The fairgrounds lets the JCHP use the arenas and barns numerous times throughout the summer without any charge. (open show, meeting and lesson nights for example). The Stall Clean Out is a fund raiser for the project as well as the 4-H members. At the end of the year, the Jefferson County Fair Park pays JCHP for every stall that was cleaned over the summer. JCHP then has the money to pay out stall points to members. It's a win/win situation. We get the use of the facilities at no cost and make some money too.

Where to find the schedule?

Look to the Jefferson County Horse and Pony website [www.jchp.org](http://www.jchp.org) to download the schedule. If your club has a conflict with the dates you are scheduled, please contact another club to switch dates.

How does Stall Clean Out work?

On the nights your club is scheduled:

- To be fair to all clubs, suggested start time is **6:00 pm**. If you need to start earlier, please call Julie Endl at 920-650-5109 to make arrangements.
- All shavings should be removed from the stalls into the aisle. (snow shovels work great) Please sweep out the stalls after shaving are removed and close and latch stall doors.
- Someone from your club records member names and a count of stalls cleaned on the Stall Cleaning form and places in the drop box at the fairgrounds, email or mail to Julie Endl, 115 E. Greenwood St, Jefferson WI 53549, [crejulie@hotmail.com](mailto:crejulie@hotmail.com).

\*\*\*\* Individual members should also keep track of stalls that they clean for point purposes. Stall count points turned in at the end of the year must match information turned in on stall cleaning night.
